

SURFACE MINE PERMIT NO. 133, REVISION No. 1, VARIANCE NO. 190005 - CEQ190076 - Applicant: RJ Noble Company - Engineer/Representative: Benchmark Resources - First Supervisorial District - Glen Ivy Area - Temescal Canyon Area Plan - Location: Southerly of Temescal Canyon Road, easterly of Cobb Drive, and westerly of Maitri Road - Gross Acreage: 33.5 acres - Zoning: Mineral Resource & Related Manufacturing (M-R-A) - REQUEST: Surface Mine Permit No. 133, Revision No. 1 (SMP00133R01): A revision to an existing Surface Mine Permit and Reclamation Plan, proposing the following: 1) Conversion of the existing old asphalt plant to a cold mix asphalt plant. 2) Increase new hot mix asphalt plant production from 600,000 tons to a maximum of 1.2 million tons per year. 3) Permit an existing pre-manufactured office building. 4) Change the permitted feed silos to feed bunkers on the mining plan. 5) Revise the cut slope configuration on the mine and reclamation plans to reflect the as-built condition. 6) The importation of inert/clean soil. Variance No. 190005 (VAR190005): Under the existing conditions of approval of SMP133 and pursuant to Ordinance No. 348 (Land Use), SMP133 may operate between the hours of 6 a.m. to 10 p.m., on any day. This Variance request is to allow the mining activities associated with SMP133 to operate for 24 hours per day, every day. In addition, Ordinance No. 348 (Land Use) requires a minimum 300-foot setback from an asphaltic concrete plant and any zone, other than the M-R, M-R-A, M-H and M-M Zones. As part of the Variance request, the applicant is requesting to locate the asphalt production facility within the 300-foot required setback from the west-adjacent property zoned Residential Agricultural (R-A-10) and the south-adjacent property zoned Natural Assets (N-A). - APN: 290-110-020 - BBID: 644-413-878




